## <u>Attendance</u>

We had a fantastic attendance celebration on Monday morning. It was such a lovey way to start the new term and there were so many families who joined us. Anyone with 97% and above will be invited but with special awards for our 100% attendance children.

If your child is going to be absent due to a medical appointment, which should be taken out of school times whenever possible, please keep appointment cards/letters and again there is a form for you to fill out at the office.

Please remember schools are being asked not to grant any leave of absence unless it is exceptional and fines have to be issued for any time taken off during term time.

In September 2013 the **Education (Pupil Registration)** (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 came into force. These regulations make it clear that Headteachers should not grant approval for any leave of absence during term-time, including holidays, unless there are exceptional circumstances.

We will be sending out a form on our School Dojo page for people to fill in if they would like to do any volunteering e.g. reading with children. It will ask you when you have availability and if you have any particular skills you think we could utilise in school. Please look out for this form next week.
