Attendance Update

We are continuing to work hard as a school to improve attendance. We currently have very low attendance compared to similar schools and the local area, so we ask kindly for you to work with us to ensure we improve this. Thank you.

Please continue to ensure your child is not late for school but if there is an occasion that can't be helped there is a form for you to fill out on arrival at school at the main office.

If your child is absent/late please phone to give reasons (01773 713429).

If your child is going to be absent due to a medical appointment, which should be taken out of school times whenever possible, please keep appointment cards/letters and again there is a form for you to fill out at the office.

Please remember schools are being asked not to grant any leave of absence unless it is exceptional, and fines have to be issued for any time taken off during term time.

In September 2013 the Education (Pupil Registration) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 came into force. These regulations make it clear that Headteachers should not grant approval for any leave of absence during term-time, including holidays, unless there are exceptional circumstances.
