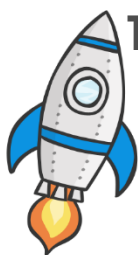
### Maths at our school

This year we have a whole school focus on fluency in maths so that the children can apply their number skills in different lessons.

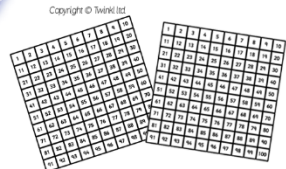

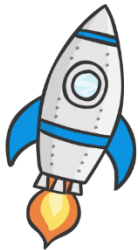
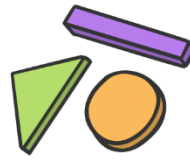
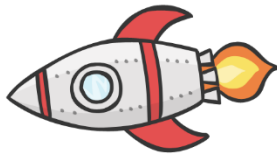
You won't even realise you are doing maths....

- How many numbers can you find in your house?





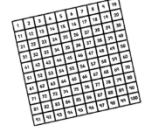
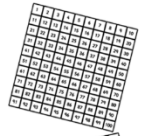
