<u>Attendance</u>

Attendance is so important and as we have made you aware by sharing the Government and Local Authority Guidance has become even tighter in schools. The way we have to monitor and review attendance as a school is extremely rigorous. We are only ever trying to support families so please come and see us if there is anything we need to know or anything we can help with.

We want to ensure we are all working together to get the best for every child.

At the start of the new school year, we saw a massive improvement with our lateness but this has continued to slip since last terms newsletter so please try really hard. Just 5 minutes late every day is 25 minutes over a week this soon mounts up over a year. If your child is late there is a form for you to fill out on arrival at school.

If your child is absent/late please phone to give reasons (01773 713429). If your child is absent due to medical appointments, which should be taken out of school times whenever possible, please keep appointment cards/letters and share with us and again there is a form for you to fill out.

Please remember schools are being asked not to grant any leave of absence unless it is exceptional, and fines have to be issued for any time taken off during term time. If you require a form to complete for a leave of absence, please see Mrs Downing or Mrs Johnson in the main office.

Please remember the changes this year around fines. (we sent these out at the start of the year, please ask if you would like another copy)
