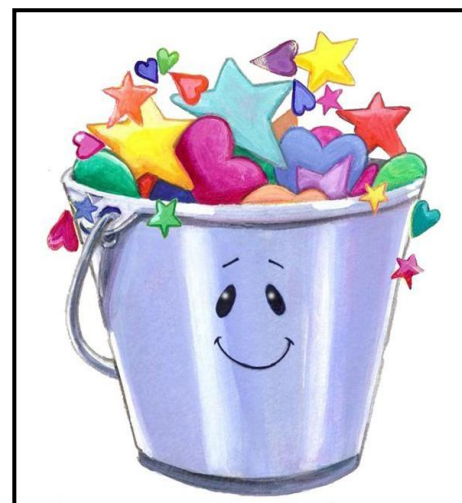


All pupils, staff, parents/carers and governors will work together to follow our ‘Bucket Filling Fillosophy’:
