Langley Mill Church of England Infant School and Nursery

**Consultation on a Proposal by the Governing Body for the Extension of the Age
Range of the School from 3- 7years to 2-7 years**

Context

We are an Infant and Nursery School with a PAN (Pupil Admission Number) of 40 pupils. Each class will only have 30 pupils per class. We currently have a School Led Nursery (for children 3 years and above) with 26 children per session. We have both 15- and 30-hour places available.

Proposal

We are proposing to extend our Nursery provision to include 2-year-olds.

We propose to initially enrol 10 children from the start of the term after they become 2 years old. In line with our current Nursery intake we will have three entry points one in September, one in January and one after the Easter holidays.

Staff

There will be no redundancies or reductions in staffing as a result of this change.

Funding

We have consulted with School Support Finance who have modelled the anticipated funding and built it into our budget monitoring spreadsheet. They recognise that this is a sustainable financial model for us.

Consultation

The consultation on this proposal will be from **14 September 2026 to 28 September 2026**.

A meeting will be arranged with all interested parties to explain the proposal and respond to questions. This will take place on – **Monday 21st September 2026 at 4pm**
